Delegates will gain required knowledge and understanding to conduct gas test for oxygen levels, flammable and toxic gases safely. Delegates will be equipped with knowledge to conduct gas testing within confined spaces, relevant requirements and documenting gas test results.

- This programme is designed for personnel preparing to work as Authorized Gas Testers Level 1 and is required for those involved with performing a test for oxygen, flammable and toxic gases up to and including working in confined spaces.

- Calibrating the instruments used in atmospheric testing The behavior of different flammable and toxic gases

- Determination of acceptable levels of flammable and toxic gases. Monitoring and retesting and where to site ongoing monitoring equipment Interpreting and documenting the results

AUTHORIZED BREATHING APPARATUS USER LEVEL 1
