






## **ASSP-KC MEMBERS ACHIEVEMENTS**







## **ASSP-KC PRESENTS SAFETY ALERT**



#### **BIO HACKING the body...Through IMPLANT Technology**





**Biohacking**, as the term itself indicates, reflects a combination of biology and hacking, in this technology, the individuals can hack their bodies to achieve certain goals which may include improving the physical strength, or boosting the brain memory, or to use it as technological advancements.

Bio hacking your body means changing your chemistry and physiology through science and self-experimentation to increase energy and vitality. There are lot methods on biohacking which includes;

- 1. Life style and Dietary Changes
- 2. Wearable technology
- 3. Genetic Engineering
- 4. Implant Technology

The possibilities of biohacking are endless, but they all are rooted in the idea that we can change our bodies and our brains, and that by doing so we can ultimately, become smarter, faster, and better as human beings.

Now many in the biohacking world consider implanted technology the next level, but it is not mainstream yet. Yet the technology exists for microchips, bionic eyes, mind-controlled drones and gene editing.

Intake of supplements, gene sequencing research in laboratories, wearable gadgets and body implants are all included in Biohacking.

Although you all may know a lot about wearables, as it has become too common such as;

- Watches (Apple, Samsung, Fitbit and many more)
- Contact Smart Cards (Employee tags, Door openers)
- •Contactless Smart Cards (Attendance systems, Debit card, Credit card chips)
- Proximity Cards (Car Parking cards)
- Hybrid Cards (in Devices)
- Combi-Cards (Combination of chips)

However, the body implants are still not well known to the masses. So, let's get an insight about the Biohacking implants with microchips enabled with RFID and what difference will it make in the coming years, since the cost can be low as US \$ 300.

These chips can be implanted inside humans to let them interact with the electronic devices. You can unlock doors, computers and a lot of other gadgets. It can also connect to your payment and security systems.

Kevin Warwick, UK-based cybernetics professor, was the first person to get an RFID chip implanted in his hand. He connected it to the systems at University to operate lights and doors.

It is safer than piercings, tattoos or blood extraction and 3,000 Sweden residents are already microchipped
