## First Aid Session at College of Basic Education – Girls Campus (PAAET)

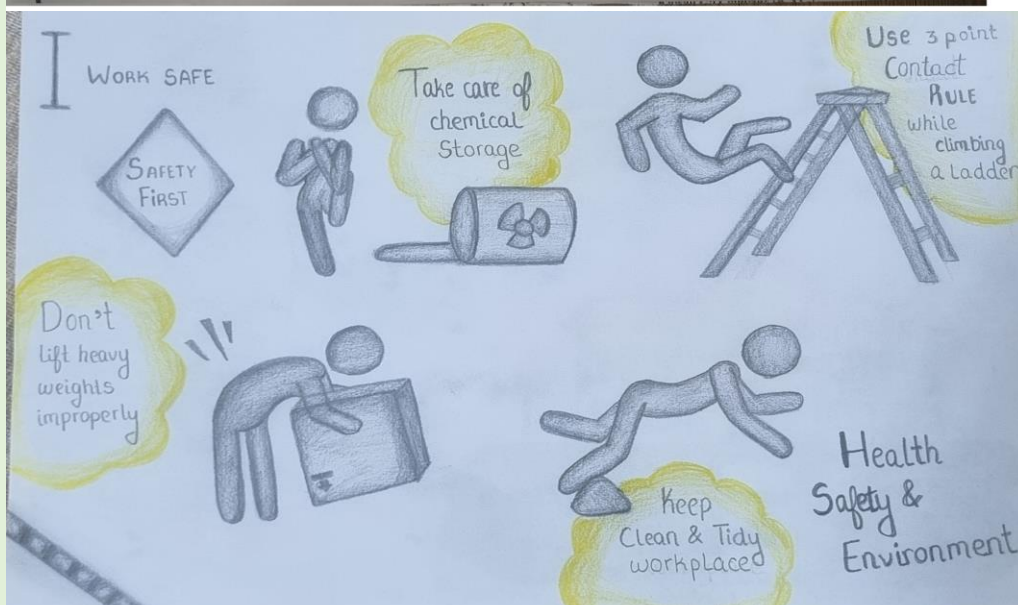
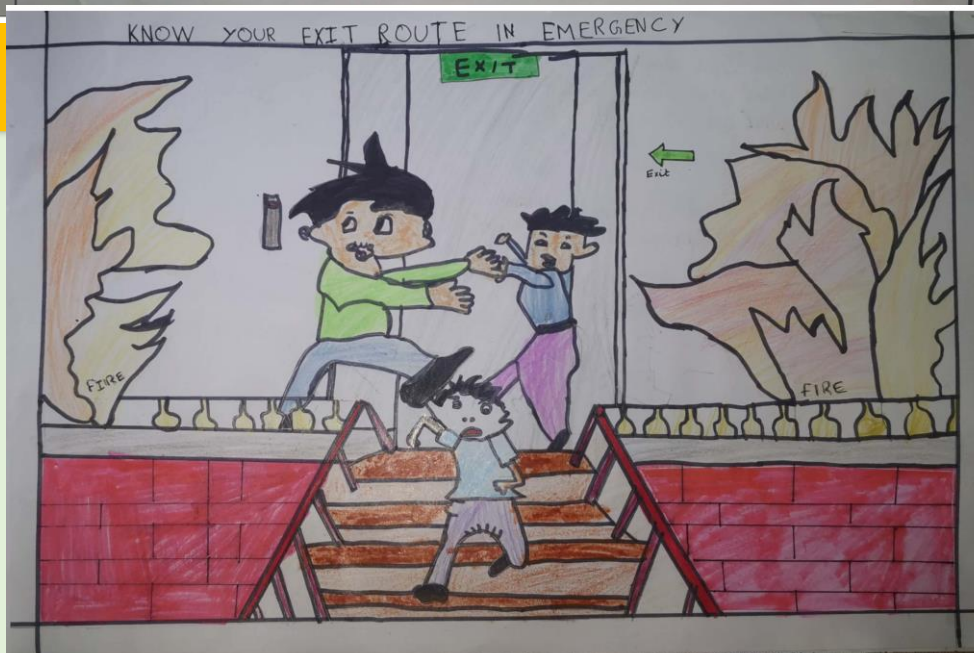

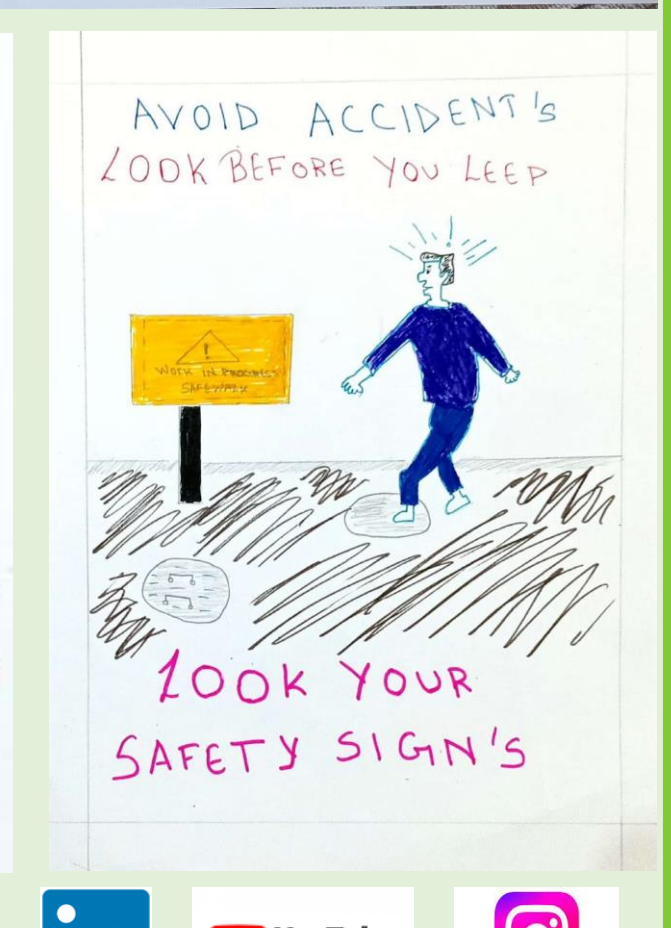
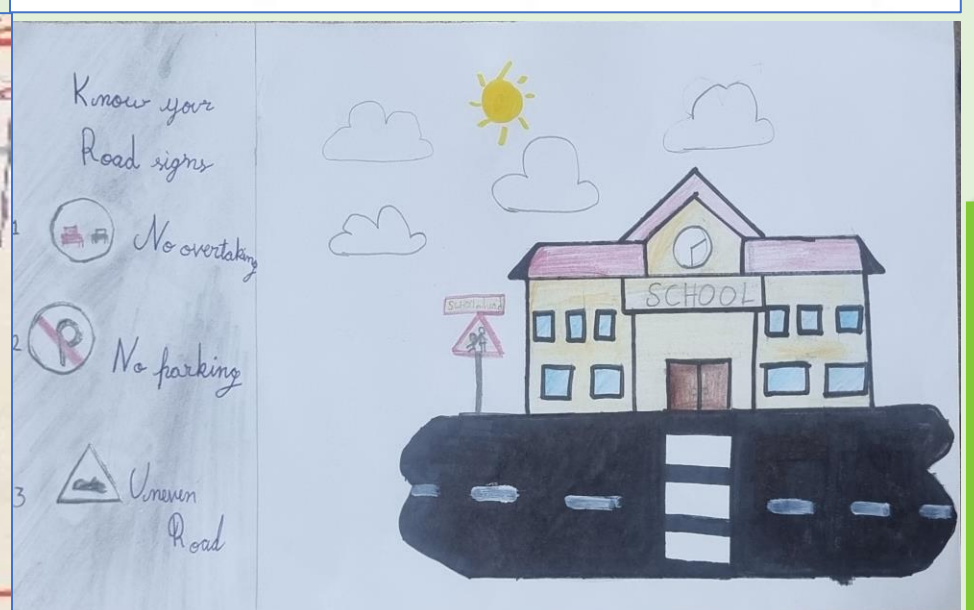
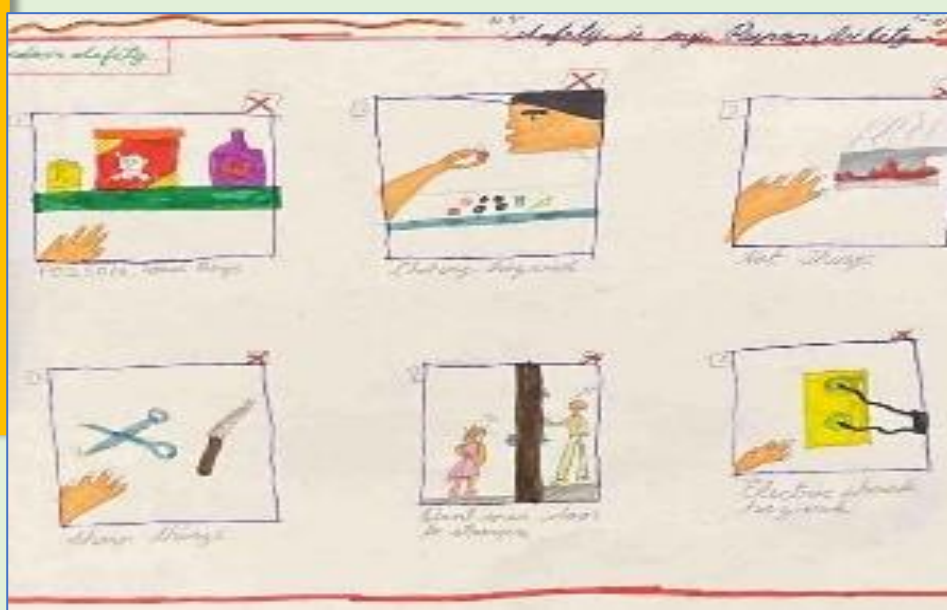
## HSE Poster Competition 2024

### How did you manage the Risk in Five basic steps

1. Avoidance.
2. Retention.
3. Spreading.
4. Loss Prevention and Reduction.
5. Transfer (through Insurance and Contracts)

### Five Steps of the Risk Management Process

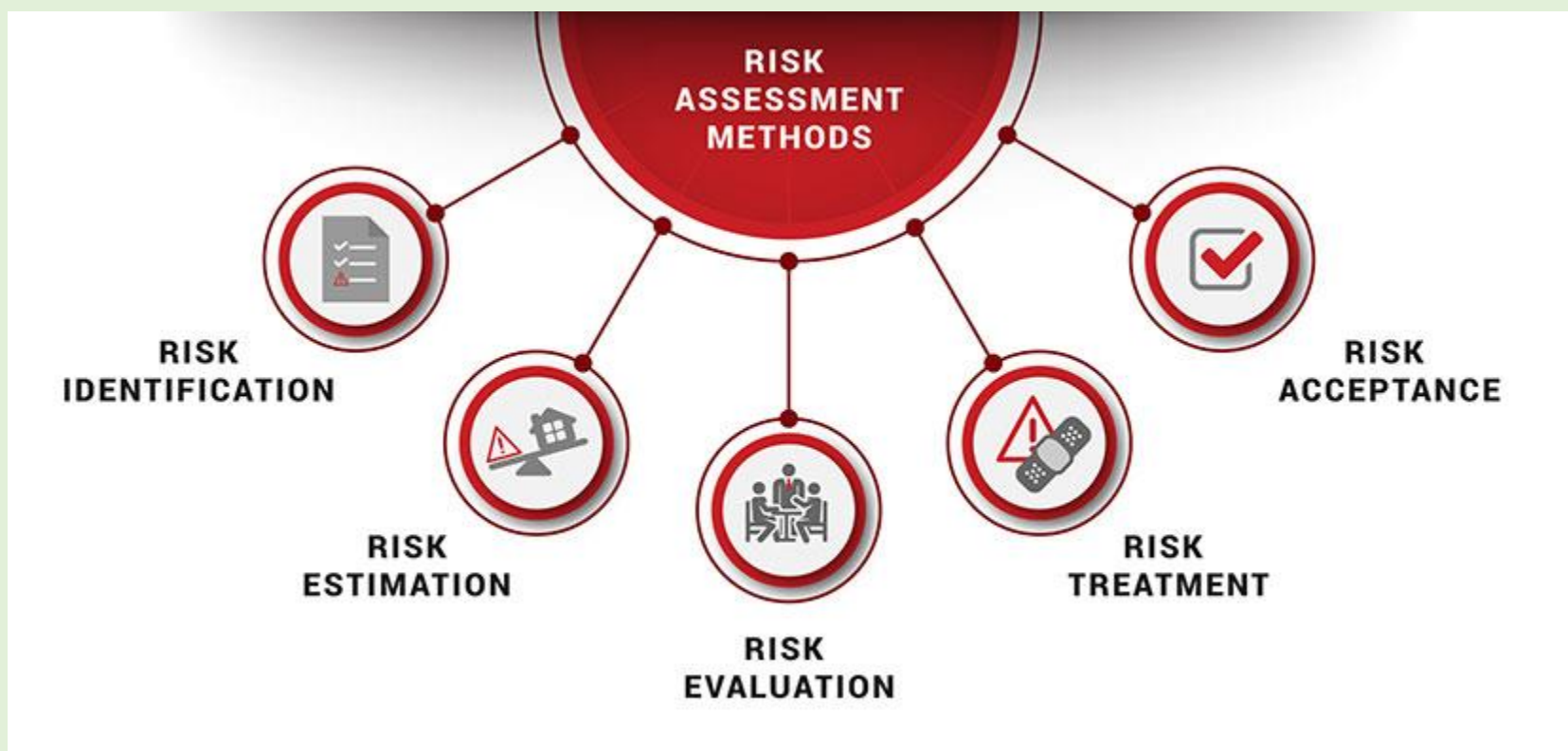
Step 1: Identify the Risk.

Step 4: Treat the Risk.

Step 5: Monitor and Review the Risk.
